Ti kaungai karikirake man botaki aika uarereke, man taabo ake I tinanikun South Tarawa ma Betio, te reirei, uarokoia mwane ao aine nakon te rikirake ae ti te tikina, tararuan te mauri ao buokaia ake iai toaraia, waaki n takakaro, te roronirikake, boutokaan inanomatan te aomata, tararuan te otabwanin, kaungaakin karikirakean te konabwai ibukin te reita ni maeu, te ununiki ao ibuobuoki nakoia koraki ake a rootaki ni kanganga aika a karina ni korakoran bibitakin kanoan bong. Tera karikirake aika a aki kona ni boutokaki n te buoka ae te DAP?

Karikirake ake a raaon ana kainibaire te buoka aei, e bon kona naba n aki boutokaaki ngkana a rin bwaai aikai n te kataumwane:

- Mwanenakin karikirake n irekereke ma kaboo n takakaro ke kaotan katein abara n akean te kamatata bwa e na kanga ni boutoka te rikirake.
- Booia taan mwakuri ke mwanenakia taan kaira te kataneiai.

What is the Direct Aid Program?

The Direct Aid Program (DAP) is a small grants program administered by the Australian High Commission in Kiribati. The program aims to support projects with a strong development focus which are designed to benefit the whole community. We encourage projects in the areas of community and/or rural development, education, gender equality, health and disability, sport, youth, human rights, the environment, economic empowerment, agriculture and ad hoc humanitarian relief. The DAP grant can give a maximum of \$20,000 for each project.



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Who can apply?

- Communities, Clubs, Villages, Churches and faith-based organisations
- Non-Government Organisations (NGOs)

Some examples of projects we fund under DAP include:

- Construction of toilets
- Purchase of water tanks / water purifiers
- Purchase of sewing machines for training purposes
- Purchase of sports equipment for a community or sport organisation
- Projects in support of early childhood education

What kind of projects can't be supported by DAP?

Beyond applicant eligibility criteria, we will not support projects that include the following ineligible items in their budget:

- Sponsorship of major sporting tournaments or cultural displays that do not have a clear developmental benefit.
- Staff salaries, or funding for trainers.
- Projects that give grants or micro-credit schemes or projects that involve the return of money, or commercial ventures
- Purchase of major assets, for example trucks
- Major construction, including building maneabas
- International travel, including Australian or overseas study tours
- Routine, recurring running costs and administrative expenses including office rental and utility costs, spare parts, routine maintenance



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
